COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Dancers must dance to music & swords supplied by the committee.
2. Any competitor not on hand when their event is called will forfeit his or her entry in that event.
3. Competitors will compete in reverse order of entry, the first, last etc. and be dressed according to SOBHD rules. Numbers must be worn.
4. Age of entry is based on competitor's age as of May 16, 2015.
5. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the necessary fee. No field entries will be accepted.
6. Competitors must be registered with ScotDance. ScotDance cards must be presented to receive number and claim prizes. You must be in full highland dress to claim prize.
7. Official SOBHD rules 7 regulations govern this competition.
8. Communications with the judge with respect to a competitor will result in disqualification of the competitor. Judges decision in final. Protests must be made in writing before the end of competition and accompanied by a \$25.00 fee, which will be forfeited if the complaint is not sustained.
9. Points taken to number of awards given according to SOBHD rules.
10. All Jig shoes must be taped.
11. There are separate change areas for males & females. Dancers are asked to utilize the appropriate areas for changing and warm-up. Dancers will not be permitted to change, warm-up or practice in the competition area.
12. Dancers are not permitted to be in the competition area wearing only bra tops or sport bras with dickies.
13. For Premier 16 & over, cash awards to be presented.
